### **...Our Speaker...**

**Corey Dyck** is a current Winnipeg Sports Car Club (WSCC) driving instructor, reigning WSCC Autocross Street-Prepared, Race tires class champion, 3-time class champion at Canadian Autocross Nationals, former WSCC Autocross director, and current Engineering Designer in New Flyer's Powertrain department. Corey has 7 years of high-performance driving, competition and instruction experience, and also holds a B.Sc. in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Manitoba.

### **...The Presentation...**

The presentation will be about the technical aspects of racing 4-wheeled vehicles in a road race and autocross environment, from characteristics of tires, to suspension, to the driver's role. It will be based on WSCC Autocross schools, but with a little more engineering-related content. There will be an open question period at the end. The presentation may be (optionally, unofficially) followed by a few races at Speedworld indoor karting track, Berry and St. Matthews (\$8 per race, not included in meeting attendance cost), so the recommended attire is jeans, plaid shirt, and a race helmet.

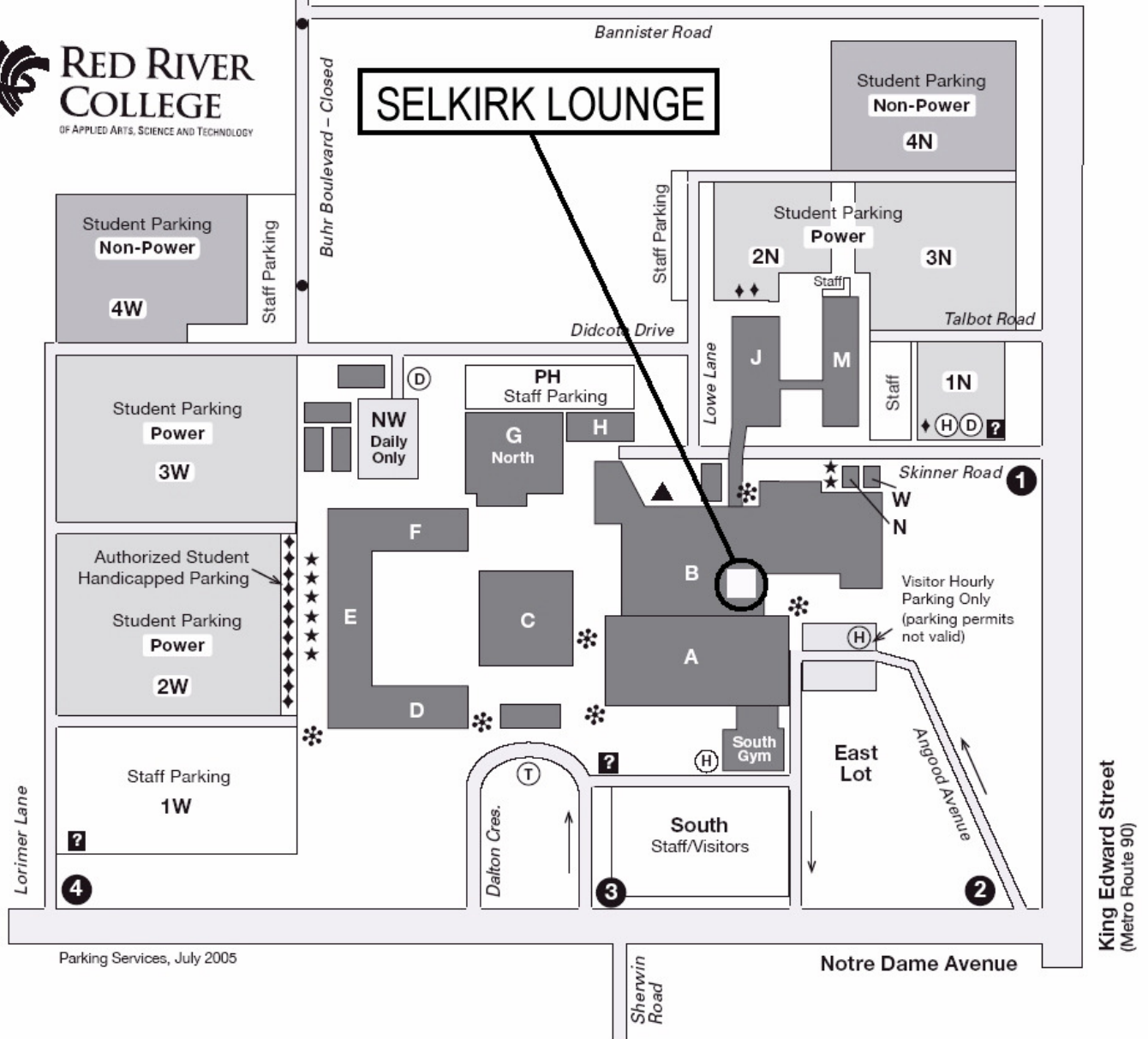
