...Our Speaker...

Mr. Harold Vokey, CET, CAE, CIM, graduated from the Mechanical Engineering Technology program at the Manitoba Institute of Technology (now known as RRC) and immediately went to work for Versatile Farm Equipment. Over several years at Versatile, Mr. Vokey held a number of positions including Product Designer, Manufacturing Planner, Machinist Apprentice, Tool and Die Maker, Senior Technical Analyst, Supervisor of CNC Programming and Manufacturing Planning, and finally as Manager of Facilities Planning. In between those positions at Versatile, Mr. Vokey briefly escaped to Bristol Aerospace as a Tooling Process Planner for jet engine components. While at Versatile, Mr. Vokey also obtained a Red Seal Certification as a Machinist.

In 1982, Mr. Vokey returned to the Mechanical Engineering Technology program at RRC as an Instructor, where he taught a variety of courses, including GD&T and Tool Design. While recently retired from RRC, he currently remains an active member of the Canadian Technology Accreditation Board for Mechanical Engineering Technology programs across Canada (other than Manitoba). Mr. Vokey also remains active in offering GD&T training courses to local manufacturing companies.

In his presentation, Mr. Vokey will introduce the reasoning, basic concepts and symbology, and advantages of using Geometric Dimensioning and Tolerancing for engineering design, technical drawings, and manufacturing.

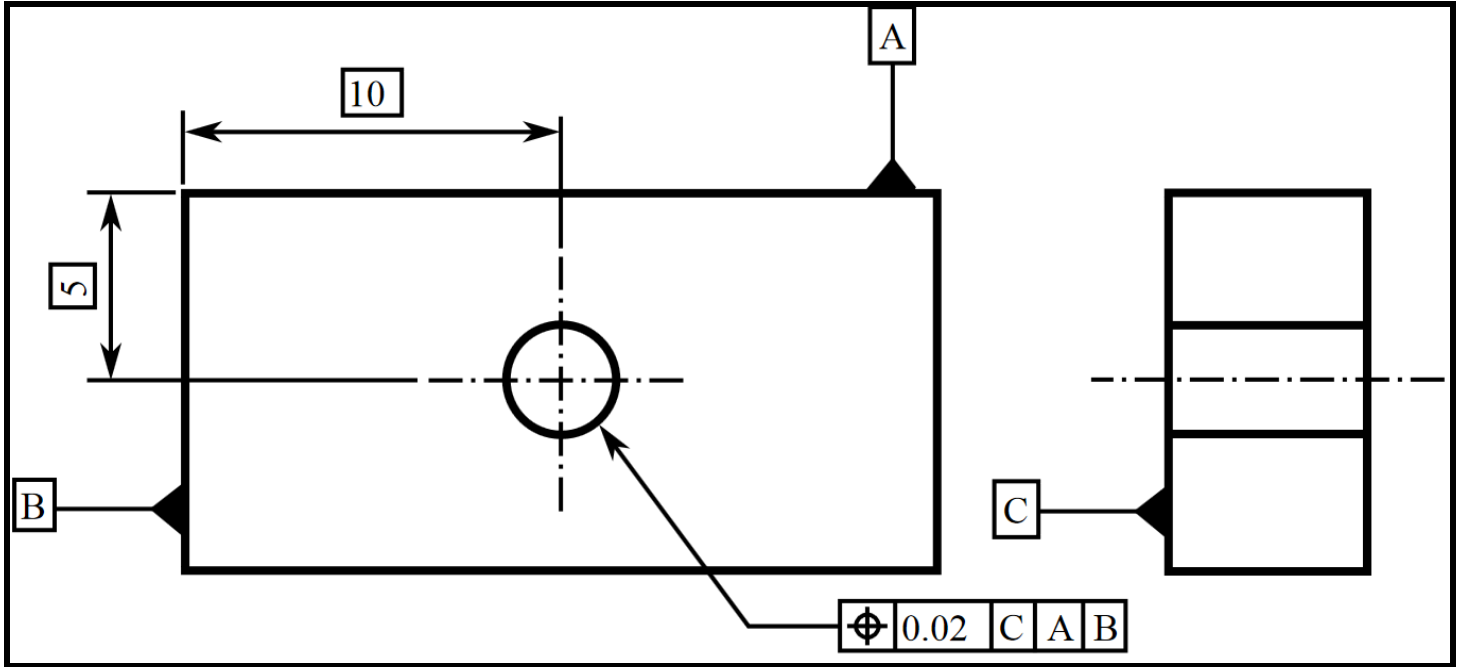


Figure 1 – Geometric Dimensioning and Tolerancing example

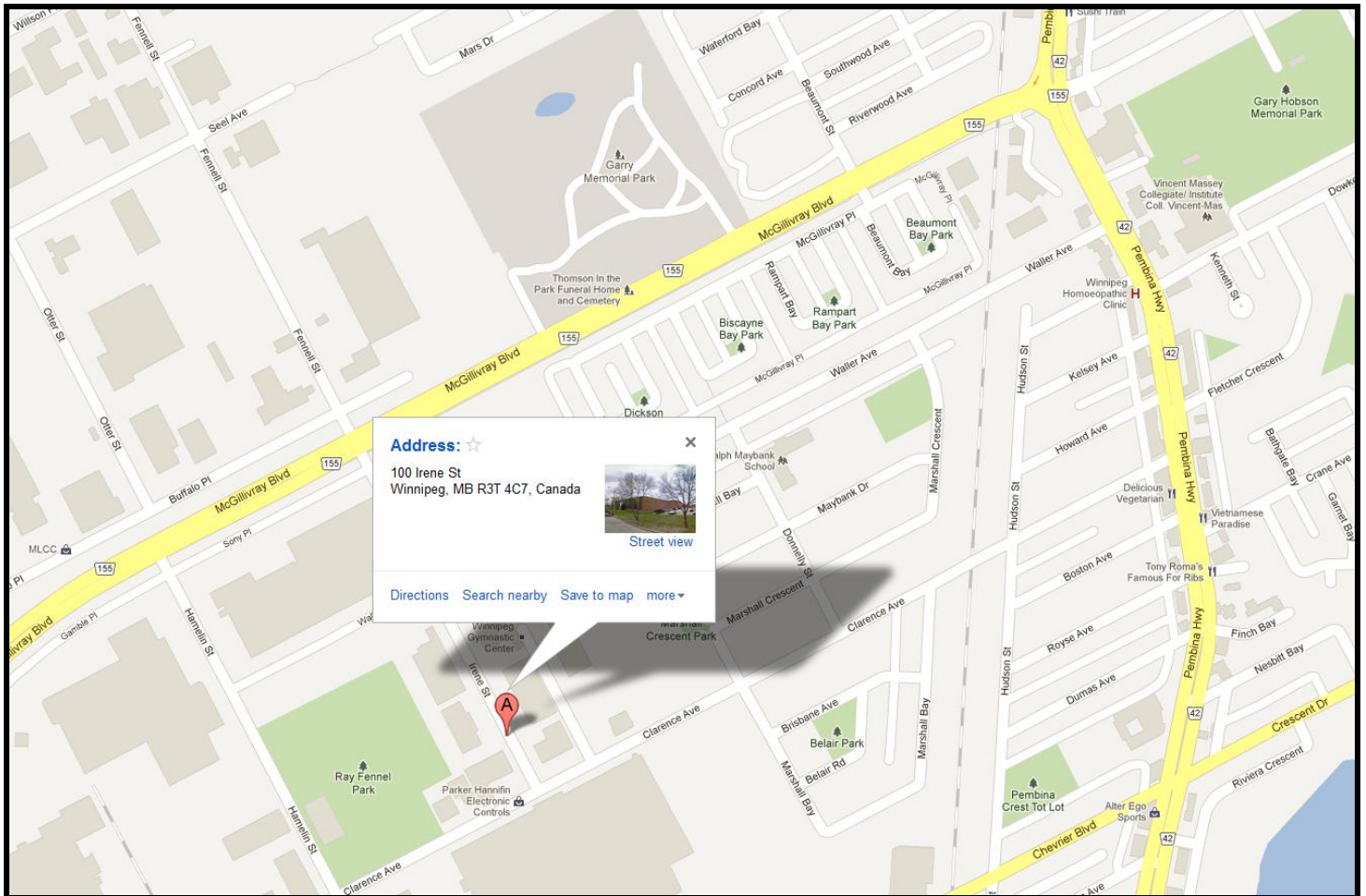


Figure 2 – Map of Parker-Vansco area
